

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING:

1. The controller of your personal data is Geis PL sp. z o. o., based in Sosnowiec-Pieńki 7 (95-010 Stryków), which is entered into the register of entrepreneurs maintained by the District Court for Łódź-Śródmieście in Łódź, 20th Commercial Division Of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000053574, NIP 5261025183, REGON 010972267, share capital: PLN 7,764,000.00, hereinafter referred to as the "Controller" or " Geis PL ".
2. Controller appointed Data Protection Officer – Mr. Paweł Markiewicz, who can be contacted at iod@geis.pl or in writing at Geis PL office address.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - 1) replying to the sent e-mail message or via a completed contact form – consent is the basis for processing (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR);
 - 2) answering calls to Geis PL hotline - processing is based on consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR);
 - 3) presenting an offer and taking actions aimed at concluding a contract – processing is based on taking steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into contract (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR);
 - 4) handling complaints regarding the concluded contract - processing is based on the performance of the contract (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR);
 - 5) establishing or pursuing claims or defending against claims - processing is based on legitimate interest pursued by Controller (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
4. The following may be the recipients of your personal data:
 - 1) providers of IT or ICT solutions;
 - 2) entities entrusted with the data by Controller for the proper performance of services to the extent necessary for these activities;
 - 3) entities authorized under the law.

6. Rights of the data subjects:
 - 1) the right to access your data receive copies thereof;
